Stifle Clinic:

A Physical Therapy Approach to Treating Your Horse's Stifle Dysfunction

Description: After introducing and presenting her **Stifle Treatment Approaches** at last year's Equine Affair 2010 in Springfield, MA. Jennifer has received numerous requests for clinic events to provide horse owners with information and instruction of her therapeutic exercise approach to treat horses that struggle with stifle dysfunction. Over the past 5 years since opening her practice, she has had many successful results with this program, progressing numerous "stifle horses" out of their dysfunction, back to working performance. If your horse suffers with "weak stifles", locking or catching, or "jumping patella", all forms of **intermittent upward fixation of patella**, then this is a clinic you will want to attend to learn more of what you can do with your horse to address these problems and return your horse back to wellness.

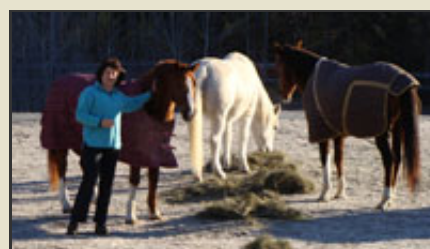

Evaluation of a "Stifle" Horse	12:30-1:30pm
6 Reserved Clinic Appointments Slots	2:00-5:00pm

Six 30-minute slots are available by advance registration for an individual 30-minute session of your horse. This opportunity allows for individual evaluation of each horse by Jennifer to assess the degree of stifle dysfunction and provide individual recommendations. These sessions are open for group auditing.

Group Therapy Session	5pm-6pm

Therapeutic exercise instruction of the previous 6 clinic participants. This 1-hour session will introduce each horse and owner to the treatment progression of stifle dysfunction beginning with isometric strengthening exercises, 4 hind end stretching, exercises, and in-hand strengthening progression. This is open to auditors.

Attendance Costs:

Morning Lecture Seminar only= \$30 (\$35 at door)
 Afternoon Clinic Auditing only= \$40 (\$45 at door)
 Full day auditing = \$ 60 (\$65 at door)

Full day attendance **with Horse***= \$100 - need to register and pay in-full in advance. Veterinarian should clear horses participating in clinic for appropriateness prior to clinic date. Please bring proof of neg. Coggins.
